# SMS/SGA PASTORAL COUNCIL MEETING – JUNE 3, 2025 FAITH FORMATION REPORT FROM DONNA SIMONE/TERRI BOUCHARD

CONGRATULATIONS TO OUR 2025 FIRST COMMUNICANTS FROM ST. GABRIEL'S AND ST. MADELEINE SOPHIE PARISHES AND SCHOOL! 72 children received the Body and Blood of Christ for the first time at Masses celebrated on April 27<sup>th</sup> at SGA Church and May 3<sup>rd</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, and 11<sup>th</sup> at SMS Church. This included several children in grades 3, 4 and 5, several of whom were the older siblings of 2<sup>nd</sup> graders.

#### CONFIRMATION PROCESS IS UNDERWAY FOR 2025 PROGRAM YEAR.

Donna has reached out to current 10<sup>th</sup> grade active/inactive Faith Formation youth from SMS/SGA and OLQP Parishes to invite them to register for Confirmation sessions in preparation for their Sacrament. \*\* We are especially proud that at least 6 families were offered free UPK through Guilderland at other locations and refused the spot. They instead have chosen to stay with us and will be paying full tuition next year. At least two of the families are new to SMS, the other 4 students are currently in our three year old program

 Summer Camp begins July 7 for 6 weeks. 70 students are signed up, choosing between one and six weeks with options for half day, full day and full day with aftercare until 5pm. Campers will attend SMS VBS during the last week of camp.

#### **OUR STRATEGIC MISSION PROCESS-UPDATE**

Dear Parishioners-

On Thursday, May 22, 2023, the pastors of the diocese gathered at Christ Our Light Parish Center in Colonie. The Bishop invited to hear the process ahead for all parishes. Fr. Brian Kelly, Vicar for the Promotion of Integral Parish Development, presented a written process entitled, "Refocusing on the Mission".

The document indicated that the "overall goal" is to "compassionately, prayerfully and strategically realign parishes/buildings/active disciples toward vibrant missionary Church life in the community, honoring memories and legacy while discerning a new way forward. This is an opportunity for renewal within our local communities to become outward evangelists in a world of changing needs, struggles and longing for God".
